


Teilhard and Suffering:

Paleontologist and theologian Fr. Pierre Teilhard de Chardin understood suffering as the inevitable result of an evolutionary universe. Absent from his work is the conventional wisdom that sees suffering as the result of sin, or of divine testing, or even an expression of the divine will.

Instead, Teilhard believed that enduring suffering generates great energy that can be used to bring about a loving world as described in Jesus' teaching of the Reign of God: "I came that you might have life—and have it abundantly" (John 10:10).
