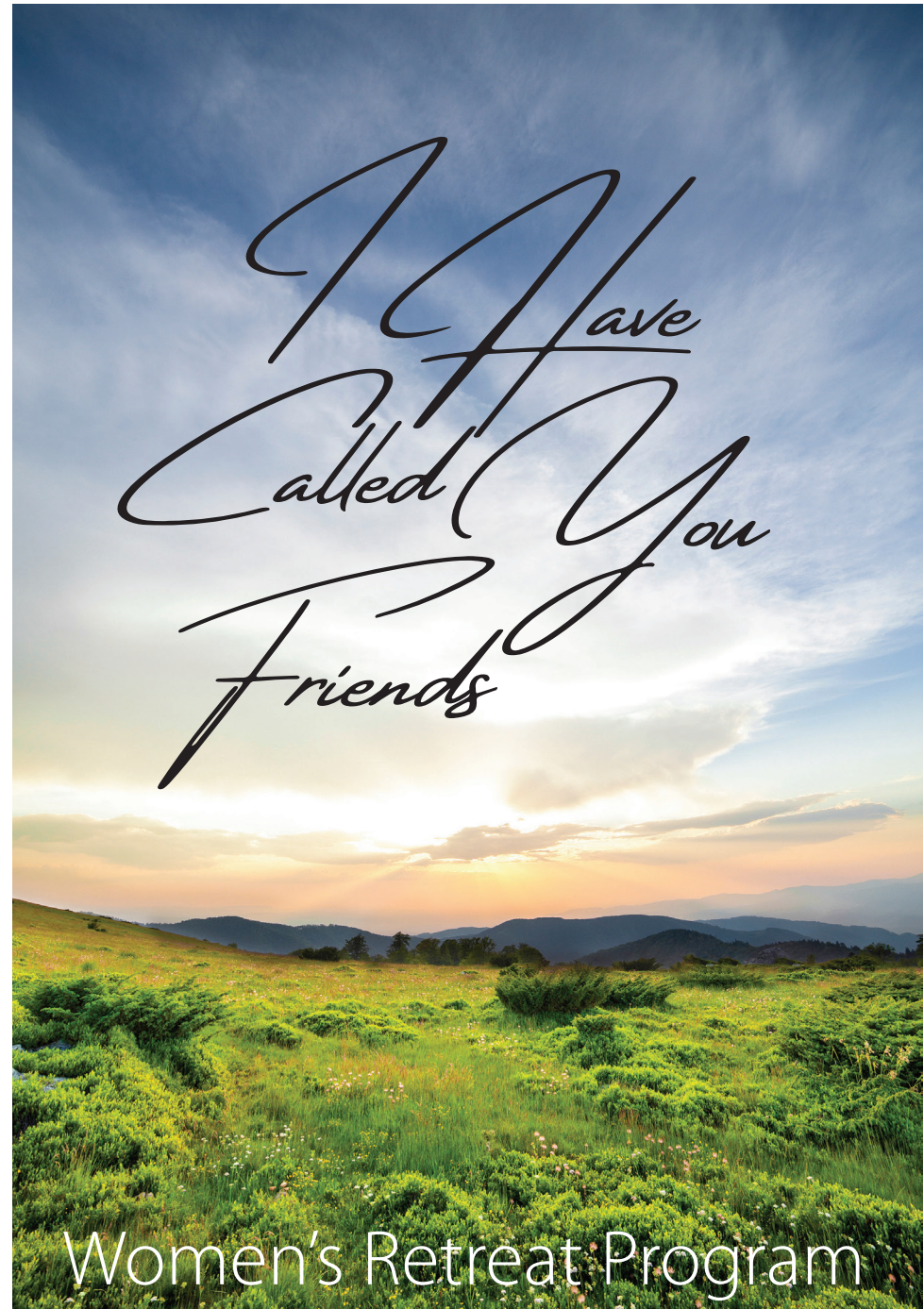
For your safety, please do not enter staff-only areas.
